## WORSHIP AT ST MARY'S

Sharing the love of Christ, the Light of the world, with the people of Ewell.



There are up to five services on a Sunday. The feel of the services is broadly traditional, with a fine organ and robed choir with a wide repertoire of choral music. Everyone is welcome, whatever faith or denomination.

08:00 Holy Communion

O9:30 Sung Eucharist with crèche, 'Children's Hour' and 'Wayfarers' for the young. This is the principal Sunday morning service.

There is coffee in the church hall between the 09:30 and 11:00 services, and a chance for members of the congregation to meet or for visitors to be welcomed.

11:00 Usually Choral Mattins, but once a month a Sung Eucharist to the 'old' Prayer Book text.

The 11:00 slot is often used for more informal services, such as 'Mattins with Holy Baptism' or services of 'Christian Family Praise'.

12:00 Holy Communion - as 08:00 (once a month)

18:30 Evening Worship varies. About once a month there is Choral Evensong.
