ELEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER TRINITY

Very basic Notes today. The services are very simple in style for three Sundays, returning to normal on 28 August. The choir is on holiday; the 0930 service is at the Nave Altar, and there is no evening worship at St Mary's throughout August.

Holy Communion is at the front of the nave only. Please return to your seats *via* the side aisles, after receiving the chalice on your 'own' side. There is no hymn at this point today.

After '*Let us pray*' **all stand** for the Post-Communion Prayer: page 182. The Mutual Salutation and the Dismissal.
